
MAG Artist Profile - Pauline Gravier


Pauline was born in Chicago and grew up in Southern California. She has always been an ardent fan of art, architecture, design and nature. These passions helped fuel a career in product design and development.

Pauline was a founder of Mottura. This small product design company received two <u>International Design Magazine</u> gold awards for innovative product and packaging. The core



product of Mottura was a personal care line featuring seven soaps inspired by nature. The





bedding line, which was featured on the Oprah Winfrey Show. Additionally, she was the location scout and photo stylist for the first Shabby Chic book.

Pauline moved back to Chicago where she was the Director of Product Development for Tag Ltd, focusing mainly on private label design projects for Crate & Barrel. After Brookstone acquired Gardener's Eden from Williams Sonoma,



Pauline moved to New Hampshire to head the GE product development team. She later relocated to southern Oregon after accepting the role of Director/Divisional Merchandising Manager with Harry & David.

During her career, Pauline traveled extensively in Europe and Asia for inspiration and to source product. Her travels led to a love of other cultures and cuisine.

Pauline began visiting Prescott when her parents retired here 20 years ago and moved here permanently in 2015. In 2019 she became the Executive Director for Mountain Artists Guild.
