Fabio Allodoli never thought of himself as an artist . He was a builder. Born in Florence, Italy, he served in the US Navy through two tours in Vietnam. In the last two years, Fabio has found and developed his artistic ability and skills through his connection with Mountain Artist Guild, and the Veterans Art Program. Many in these communities are inspired by Fabio's generous and positive spirit, despite a series of serious health challenges. His unique assemblages combine copper wire, electricity, light, shells, wood and other recycled materials. He is working on a series of wooden frames melded with branches, for his own and other MAG artist's paintings.

The prospect of representing my art together with 100 other juried artists over 10 weeks to a steadily flowing audience seemed like an exciting and inspiring challenge. It was an eye opening and life changing experience to me.

The diversity and professionalism of the vendors was inspiring. Because of the commitment required at the Expo naturally only full time artists attend, most of them having far more show experience under their belt than me.

At times, it seemed the hardest thing I have ever done. There's certainly a physical toll (especially when trying to paint in an unheated tent at 50 degrees for 8-10 hours during cold spells and rain storms), and the daily pressure can be very intense. The counterbalance comes in the shape of a wonderful artist family that cares and supports each other. This includes the organizers, who have reacted to a time of unprecedented crisis with much thought and love to their show attendees.

Daily art showing requires stamina and determination, willingness to cooperate, some extra grace, patience and humor. I'm already signed up for next year's Expo and bursting with plans and purpose for new art exploits!




MAG PHOTOGRAPHER IN PHIPPEN SHOW






