MANDATORY YAVAPAI COURTHOUSE PLAZA FESTIVAL RULES

The Courthouse Plaza is owned by Yavapai County and we are bound by the rules of operation as set forth by the County. Please read the following event rules thoroughly. Initial your understanding that any violation of these rules is subject to a fine imposed by Yavapai County.

ALL VENDORS	
Nothing can be unloaded from vehicles prior to the departure of the	
Courthouse Judges as indicated on site by the MAG Festival Director.	initial
No wheeled vehicles are allowed on the pavers.	initial
No stakes, spikes, pins or anything similar can pierce the ground. Violations are	
subject to an immediate mandatory \$50 fine per piercing. Any resulting damage	
to the irrigation system will be assessed and billed after the festival.	initial
Nothing may be propped against or tied to the trees.	initial
Tent weights must not be in contact with the ground.	initial
No flat surface areas (pedestals, boxes, storage containers, product, etc.)	
may be in contact with the ground. All flat surfaces must be elevated by PVC	
sections or wood pieces with maximum dimensions of 2"x 4"x 12".	initial
Booth break down is allowed only after the close of the festival on Saturday (5pm)	
or Sunday (4pm). Violation will result in a \$150 fine and exclusion from	
participation in future festivals.	initial
No "sale" signage may be posted.	initial
Any violation resulting in fines are the responsibility of the vendor.	initial
FOOD VENDORS	
Food booths must have a tarp on the ground.	initial
Only one 20-amp electrical circuit (2 outlets) may be used.	initial
Nothing may be dumped onto the pavement or grass.	initial
