Prior to 10/29/21	Earrings hung on a card no smaller than 1" x 1.5" and labeled individually		
Prior to 10/29/21	Necklaces, bracelets, sets, ornaments, etc. must have a hang tag, no smaller than 1" x 1.5", attached to each piece		
Prior to 10/29/21	All Prints and Greeting Cards must be in plastic sleeves
